

# Trump Admin. Extends Comment Period on China Tariffs to Sept. 6

Office of the U.S. Trade Representative says parties have until Sept. 6 to comment on proposed U.S. tariffs on \$200b worth of Chinese goods, Bloomberg Law's Dave Sebastian reports.
